An Act of 2012 to Further Amend

An Act to Accept and Restructure the Treasury Department of 20120423

An Act to Create the Bureau of Acquisitions

The People of the Republic for the United States of America in Congress Assembled present this Act:

Section I: Purpose and Title

The purpose of this act is to further amend the several acts to An Act to Accept and Restructure the Treasury Department of 20120423 by creating the Bureau of Acquisitions. This Act may be cited as An Act to Create the Bureau of Acquisitions of 2012.

Section II – Create the Bureau of Acquisitions:

Whereas, The Republic is in need of a Bureau of Acquisitions for purchasing and procurement to facilitate operations;

Therefore, Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That there shall be a Bureau of Acquisitions established within the Republic Treasury, subject to congressional oversight, that is responsible for procuring and contracting for all fixed and non-fixed assets, and processing disposition of assets. The Bureau of Acquisitions shall have a Director of Acquisitions, an Assistant Director, procurement agents, and support staff as needed.

Updates to the sections that further amend the several acts to *An Act to Accept and Restructure the Treasury Department of 20120423* are shown below, adding the Bureau of Acquisitions.

Section 1. *And be it further enacted*, That there shall be a Department of Treasury called the Republic Treasury, in which shall be the following officers, namely: a Secretary of the Treasury, to be deemed head of the department; a Comptroller, an Auditor, a Treasurer, a Register, a Commissioner of the Revenue, and a Director of Acquisitions.

Addition of new Section 11 to define the Bureau of Acquisitions:

Section 11. And be it further enacted, That there shall be a Bureau of Acquisitions established within the Republic Treasury, subject to congressional oversight, that is responsible for procuring and contracting for all fixed and non-fixed assets, and processing disposition of assets. The Bureau of Acquisitions shall have a Director of Acquisitions, an Assistant Director, procurement agents, and support staff as needed.
