An Act for the Great Seal of the Republic for the United States of America

Whereas the United States in Congress assembled approved a device for an armorial Achievement and Reverse of a Great Seal for the United States on June 20, 1782, described as follows,

'Paleways of thirteen pieces, Argent and Guiles, A Chief azure. The Escutcheon on the breast of the American Bald Eagle displayed proper, holding in his dexter talon an Olive branch, and in his sinister a bundle of thirteen Arrows, all proper, and in his beak a scroll inscribed with this motto "E pluribus unum."

For the Crest. Over the head of the Eagle which appears above the Escutcheon A Glory, or, breaking through a Cloud, proper, and surrounding thirteen stars forming a Constellation, argent, on an azure field. Reverse. A Pyramid unfinished In the zenith an Eye in a triangle surrounded with a Glory, proper; Over the Eye these words, Annuit coeptis On the base of the pyramid the numerical letters MDCCLXXVI and underneath the following Motto "Novus Ordo Seclorum".'

And Whereas the Congress of the United States has accepted and continued to use this device as the great seal for the United States;

And Whereas through re-inhabitation and restoration and reseating of de jure governance, Republic for the United States of America is the proper holder in due course chain of title to this device;

And Whereas the Municipal Corporation of the District of Columbia has unlawfully appropriated Great Seal for the United States for its own misuse;

And Whereas this misuse is misunderstood by a great many of the People in the union of several states, requiring a new device in its place for use in lawful re-inhabitation of the original republic established circa 1791,

Therefore be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of Republic for the United States of America, in Congress Assembled that, from the date enacted, a device depicting an armorial Achievement of a Great Seal and Reverse for Republic for the United States of America be described as follows,

Paleways of thirteen pieces, Argent and Guiles, a chief azure. The Escutcheon round on the breast of the American Bald Eagle displayed, proper, holding in his dexter talon an olive branch, and in his sinister a bundle of thirteen arrows, all proper, and in his beak a scroll inscribed with this motto, "From Many, One".

At the crest, a scroll with words, "Strong for Peace". For the helm, a glory, or on azure, radiates to a cloud, encircling all.

On the Reverse, the Liberty Bell, being a great bell with a crack, proper, on a field azure of fifty stars argent; beneath the bell a scroll with the words "Lev. 25:10", all encircled by the inscription, "Proclaim LIBERTY throughout all the land unto all the inhabitants".
